Comply with all applicable laws and respect internationally recognized human rights, in accordance with the UN Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights, and in particular:

- Providing safe and healthy working conditions
- Opposing all forms of forced and compulsory labor
- The effective abolition of child labor
- The elimination of discrimination in respect of employment and occupation
- The freedom of association and the effective recognition of the right to collective bargaining
- Respecting the human rights in communities impacted by our activities

How we work

- We require all our employees and hired contract workers to comply with this policy
- We expect our suppliers and business partners to share our commitment to respect all internationally recognized human rights when working for or together with us.
- We will strive to influence our business relationships to avoid or mitigate adverse impacts to human rights linked to our activities.
